#### Old Business:

Field Report: Lee Rice reported that the main runway has had fertilizer applied and that the runway is in good shape for the upcoming flying season.

By-Laws Amendment: The attending club members voted to clarify the club's membership dues structure by making the regular membership dues \$60.00 and the gate key is \$1.00, and the senior membership dues \$30.00 and the gate key is \$1.00. Information regarding the changes in the club's dues structure were posted in June's Tail Spinner Newsletter, which was available to all club members before the June business meeting.
